
Commissioner Hall motioned to suspend the rules to answer questions about what Commissioners do

The Commissioners each explained what they do.



Walter Woods reminded all that UMES's Homecoming was scheduled for February 23 – March 1.


- X. Commissioners Comments

All were in favor






