- IV. Second Budget Reading Fiscal year 2021-2022
  - President Lionel Frederick read over the reasoning of the budget.
  - Read a breakdown of each department.
  - Question was asked: Was this the same budget reading from Town Hall. The answer was yes.
  - Motion to adopt Ordinance 021-002.
  - Four commissioners in favor of the budget, one opposed. Pres. Lionel Frederick, Vice Pres. Garland Hayward, Commissioner Marshall Corbin, & Commissioner Dell Taylor were all in favor. Commissioner Joey Gardner opposed.
- V. Manokin Park Committee discussion.
  - Expand to all town parks instead of just Manokin Park. (Dale Parker)
  - Carrie Samis: Main Street Princess Anne would want to be on board.
  - Invasive species removal.
  - Vice Pres. Garland Hayward would like for this to start off as a committee.
  - The last time the Manokin Park was running was in 1999/2000.
  - Consider getting grants to help.
  - Five-member committee.
  - The community does not want to exclude Manokin Park but to include it with other parks.
  - All were in favor of the Manokin Park committee.
  - We do have a Parks and Rec within the Town.
  - The committee will be advisory.
- VI. Main Street Princess Anne Presentation

- Over 400 people attended Juneteenth. (June 19th, 2021)
- A lot of old businesses are reopening.
- New businesses are coming to Main Street.
- 5,000 people virtually watched the Muskrat dive.
- Was able to help other businesses get mask, face shields back when the pandemic first started.
- The purpose is to make Main Street more presentable.

#### VII. Rename Beckford Park to Earl Jordan

- Honor a lifelong resident of Princess Anne.
- Had a mobile snowball stand along with providing groceries.
- Left a huge impact on the residence.
- Write up credentials as to why.
- There would need to be a resolution.

#### VIII. Town Manager Report

- Attended the EBC board meeting.
- Meeting with the county executive in July. (First week)
- In late May the county stopped doing inspections and now has been transferred over to the Town.
- Getting a temporary consultant for Code Compliance director.
- Holding interviews for Nuisance and Abatement.
- Installing Fiber optics on Somerset near Prince Williams Street.

#### IX. Police Reports

- Attended meeting with department heads.
- Attended meeting with Sheriff's office, UMES, State Attorneys Office.
- Attended County wide Scout meeting.
- 524 incidents in May all have been closed.
- 110 traffic citations, 215 warnings.

- Went to Somerset Reserves to interact with kids that live the area. Played games with them as well.
